

Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2026/B/7379182-C1

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Experience Certificate for the supply of the same to any Govt/ PSU/ any renowned private organisation along with Supply/ Purchase Order.
2. If the agency is registered under MSME or NSIC, then EMD exemption certificate needs to be enclosed.
3. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
4. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. [Click here to view the file](#)
5. **Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid
6. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 50 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 50 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.
7. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
8. Escalation Matrix For Service Support : Bidder/OEM must provide Escalation Matrix of Telephone Numbers for Service Support.
9. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Chennai payable at Chennai
. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.
10. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Chennai payable at Chennai
. After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.
11. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) are exempt from submission of EMD (Bid security). Bidders claiming exemption of EMD under this rule (170 of GFR) are however required to submit a signed Bid securing declaration (format enclosed) along with the relevant and valid exemption certificate issued by the appropriate authorities. The Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) bidders to note and ensure that nature of service and goods/ items manufactured mentioned in MSE certificate matches with the nature of the service and good

s/item to be supplied as per tender for claiming EMD exemption.

The successful bidder upon order acceptance, a contract should be signed on Rs.100/- Non-judicial stamp paper, between BCGVL and the successful bidder.

Optional Site Visit : The bidder is advised to visit and examine the installation site (BCGVL, Chennai) and obtain for itself on its own responsibility all information that may be necessary for preparing the bid. The cost of visiting the site shall be borne by the bidder.

All Bidders have to submit Integrity Pact in the prescribed format enclosed in the Bid. It may be noted that Successful Bidder shall submit the Integrity Pact in Rs.100/- Non Judicial Stamp Paper on receipt of contract/order.

The service provider shall be solely responsible for payment of wages / salaries and allowances to his personnel that might become applicable under any government order. The buyer shall have no liability whatsoever in any manner.

The buyer shall not be responsible for any injury partial or permanent or death of any worker/dedicated manpower at site due to accident or any other reasons or by personal negligence of the staff of the contractor. The buyer will remain indemnified by the service provider on this account.

The payment will be made on quarterly basis (if the services are satisfactory) as applicable, on submission of bill and attendance sheet certified by BCGVL officials, on completion of each quarter as applicable, after deducting penalty amount, if any.

BCGVL regular working days is from Monday to Saturday (10.00 am to 5.00 pm)

The contract is initially for a period of one year and renewable every year subject to satisfactory performance.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
